- Directory of Company Officers, Location wise
- Pay Scale of Officers

- Share holding pattern both for AYCL and Group Companies
- AGM Notification
- Vision & Mission
- MOU Performance

- Awards & Achievements
- Current Job openings
- Supplier Registration

Selected Pages will be in bilingual languages (English & Hindi). All contents will be mandatory in English. Although some pages will be in Hindi but will not content Hindi Data (like Financial Reports, Tenders etc.).

At the outset of the web page, user will be given choice for language selection. It is also possible to switch between languages from within any selected language.

Professional look and feel should be there. State-of-the-Art Technology should be used while designing the web site. Minimum mouse click would take the user to the desired information. No detailed information should be there in the main pages. By looking at the synopsis, if user desires he/she may go to the details.

Login facility should be there for the desired users. All data which will be submitted by the user can be retrieved by the authority with suitable identification for statistical report.

User Id maintenance (creation/deletion/modification) facility should be there. Only authorized user can do the same.

We will have our own mail Server to be kept at our HO by which we may control mail id and other mail related housekeeping.

We will implement an integrated application software system shortly with e-governance facility. This system should be compatible with the new website for data handshaking. Details may be given at a later date.

Facilities for downloading tools like (Acrobat, Flash, Internet explorer, Hindi Fonts etc.) should be there for the users who do not have those in their computer.
