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1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier

as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

5. Bid Splitting: Bid quantity will be split amongst number of sellers as indicated above, as per bid splitting criteria given above. L1 would be awarded contract for quantity as indicated in the bid splitting clause above. For the rest of the bid quantity, the L-1 rates / lowest accepted rate will be counter offered to the other higher quoting bidder(s) for price matching. On acceptance of the counter offer, the order will be placed on next higher quoting bidder(s) for the respective quantity as per splitting criteria. In case of non-acceptance of the counter offer by some of the next higher quoting bidder(s), left over quantity would be allocated to next higher quoting bidders. In case counter offered rates are not accepted by any of the subsequent bidders, the left over quantity will be divided between bidders who have accepted the rates in the ratio of their originally allocated quantities subject to their confirmation and subject to quoted quantity limit and after getting consent on mutually agreed delivery schedule for the additional quantity.

6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

7. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

General conditions

1. The truck/trailer has to be placed within 24 hrs of placing our demand for the same, failing which you will be liable for payment of appropriate penalty charges. Our tentative demand for placing the trucks/trailers will be intimated well in advance from time to time.
2. Materials are to be delivered within reasonable time as given below and for delay in delivery; penalty will be deducted from the bills.

3. Guaranteed delivery time of materials has to be clearly mentioned by the contractor well in advance, so that unloading at site will be arranged without any delay/default.
4. If consignments are not delivered within the transit time allowed reckoning, grace period etc. a penalty @ 2% of the total freight charges per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% shall be levied. Additional grace period of two (2) days over transit time shall be allowed for computing penalty.
5. No intermediate transshipment of the goods will be allowed, irrespective of the destination.
6. FORCE MAJEURE: - In case of breakdown/accident when the goods are in transit, the contractor should inform all the details immediately for taking alternate steps as well as for Insurance claims.
7. INSURANCE: we will insure the material/goods after loading of the goods on your truck/trailer up to the destination point. In case insurance authority insists on producing any documentary evidence, the same should be furnished to us. In the event of any unforeseen incidence during the transit the same should be intimated to us within 24 hrs. We will arrange Insurance survey and only after completing such formalities the material should be further moved. During this period you have to arrange for the safe custody of the material. In case of any short supply you are responsible for the same and the cost will be recovered from you.

You have to obtain the Receipted Challan from the customer/consignees for the safe receipt of the complete quantity and the same should be handed over to AYCL perungudi within seven days of delivery. One photocopy copy of the same should be enclosed along with your bill. You have to also ensure that original Cenvat copy of Gate Pass is handed over to the consignee. However as and when specific instructions are given the original Gate Pass should be returned to our Office.

The oil level in the transformer will be marked by us and it should be acknowledged by your representative /lorry driver before dispatch at our factory and the same should be reconfirmed by the consignee on receipt of transformer at their end.

Please note that shortage of any item including oil will be recovered from the bills, as the same is not covered under transit risk.

8. DETENTION CHARGES: For calculating detention charges the date of material reaching the destination and date of unloading will not be considered. Nominal delay up to 2 days will not

attract any detention charges. However for abnormal delay the detention charges have to be indicated in the Price bid.

9. Acknowledgement of receipt of goods by Customer: It is the responsibility of the transporters to obtain a clean receipt from the consignee for having delivered all the materials in good condition. The acknowledgement should be signed by the authorities with seal & date. If any qualifying/conditional acknowledgement is received then the transporter will be responsibility for any claim made by the consignee. In case no acknowledgement is produced, then the transporter is liable for claim of the entire value of goods.

Price Variation Clause (PVC)
